In Romans 12:1, the apostle Paul encourages Christians to offer their whole bodies in service to God. As part of your home devotional times this week, draw a large outline of a body (or trace around someone). Talk about how we can use different parts of our bodies (eyes, ears, hands, feet etc.) to serve God and confess our faith in Jesus. Write your ideas onto the paper. Place your body drawing up onto a wall and use it as a focal point for action and prayer during the week.



Romans 12:6-8 lists a number of different gifts that God gives to his people: telling others the Good News (prophecy), helping others, teaching, encouraging, sharing or giving, leading, and showing kindness to others. Name the gifts you see at work in different members of your family. Talk about ways you can use these gifts to serve God in your church, family and community.
